He had to [D] walk it by him- [G] -self. [G-HOLD] 2-3-4

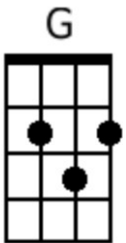
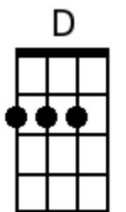
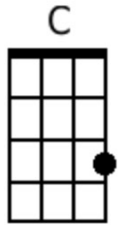
## INSTRUMENTAL: REPEAT VERSE
