[F] Keep it compan-[C-SLAP!]- -y

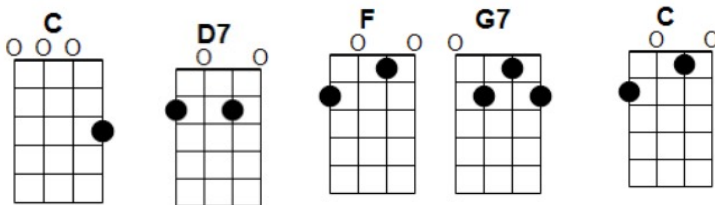
That's the song that I [C] hear, Let the world sing to- [D7] -day.
